Extending on his successful breakfast presentation in 2008, Professor Solomon's presentation will summarize 10 years of experience in attempting to motivate the Provinces and Territories to enact progressive legislation, and what Professor Solomon has learned working as an academic with MADD Canada.

Most recently, the International Council on Alcohol, Drugs and Traffic Safety named Professor Solomon the recipient of the 2007 Widmark Award. The Widmark Award acknowledges an outstanding, sustained and meritorious contribution to the advancement of traffic safety science and research. Professor Solomon was awarded this prestigious recognition for his life's work, including his tireless public advocacy for legislative reforms to reduce alcohol-related deaths and injuries in Canada, particularly among young people.
