Seminar Topic: **iRAP (International Road Assessment Programme)**

Each year 1.2 million people die and a further 50 million are injured or permanently disabled in road crashes. This scale of human tragedy is preventable.

The international Road Assessment Program (iRAP) is active in over 50 countries. In low and middle income countries iRAP work in partnership with Government and non-government agencies to identify high return engineering measures that will save many lives in the years to come.

The iRAP outcomes include:

- star ratings of the road network (for pedestrians, bicyclists, motorcyclists and vehicle occupants)
- a detailed network-wide countermeasure programme (e.g. the iRAP Malaysia Program will deliver an estimated 32% reduction in road trauma levels).

Similar programs have been completed or are now underway in Singapore, Vietnam, China, Costa Rica, Chile, Argentina, Peru, South Africa, Kenya, Nigeria and Serbia.
