ETSC – the European Transport Safety Council**

CARRS-Q is pleased to invite you to attend a breakfast seminar featuring Professor Richard Allsop, Emeritus Professor of Transport Studies, University College London.

Professor Allsop has extensive experience in research, training and advisory work on road safety, traffic management and other aspects of transport policy gathered over his many year's working within this field. He is a Fellow of the Royal Academy of Engineering and is a member of the UK Government's Road Safety Advisory Panel and chairs its Statistics Group. He is a Board Member of the European Transport Safety Council (ETSC) and chairs its road safety performance indicator programme PIN, and is a Director of PACTS, the UK Parliamentary Advisory Council for Transport Safety.

During his presentation, Professor Allsop will cover current research projects of the ETSC including those involving national research organisations and independent researchers from 30 countries who have been providing the best data available in their countries about a range of aspects of road safety, and how this data, together with information from cross-national European sources, has been used to compare a range of aspects of performance quantitatively among the countries.
