**Evaluation of the New Jersey Graduated Licensing Program**

CARRS-Q is pleased to invite you to attend a breakfast seminar featuring Dr Allan Williams, former Chief Scientist and Senior Vice President (Research) at the US Insurance Institute for Highway Safety in Arlington, Virginia.

During his time in this position he conducted a wide variety of highway safety research with emphasis on alcohol and other drugs, occupant restraint use and young drivers. He has published widely in this area and has a long-standing interest in young driver licensing practices and research in Australia and New Zealand.

In 1997, he was a recipient of the Widmark Award presented by the International Council on Alcohol, Drugs and Traffic Safety (ICADTS) which recognises outstanding and meritorious accomplishment in the field of alcohol, drugs and traffic safety.

During his presentation, Dr Williams will present a detailed evaluation of the State of New Jersey's, graduated licensing program. As the only US State where licenses are granted at 17 years of age and not 16, they have a very strong graduated licensing program that applies to all beginners not just those under age 18 as in other US states.

With policies more often found outside the US, New Jersey provides an example more aligned with current Australian licensing policies and so Dr Williams will discuss the apparent coming together in the way governments around the world are dealing with the young driver problem.
