DRINK DRIVING REHABILITATION PROGRAM

Under the Limit is a 'hands-on' interactive drink driving rehabilitation program designed to provide you with an understanding of the effects of alcohol on driving. The program also provides you with the skills and knowledge to stop drinking and driving.

Program details

- Attend a one and a half hour session per week, for 11 weeks
- Run from local venues in the community
- You cannot attend if under the influence of alcohol or illicit drugs

To be eligible via the Courts

- You must have recently been convicted with a drink driving offence
- Prior to commencing the program, pay the program fee
- The Magistrate may provide the opportunity for you to undertake the UTL program

To enrol yourself

The program is available to people outside the court system who consider they may have a drink driving problem by self referral.
