Welcome to the third edition of the **Under the Limit** newsletter. **Under the Limit** is a drink driving educational/rehabilitation program which aims to prevent future episodes of drink driving by offenders. The program is run over 11 weeks, with offenders attending for 1 ½ hours each session.

### Stakeholders Meeting

The bi-annual Stakeholders Meeting was held on the 19th of November 2010 at QUT, Kelvin Grove. Members from the Chief Magistrates Office, Magistrates Court, Queensland Police Service, Department of Transport and Main Roads and Probation and Parole attended. An update on the operational review and program evaluation was provided. Feedback from the International Council on Alcohol, Drugs and Traffic Safety was presented by CARRS-Q staff who attended the conference in Oslo, Norway in August 2010.

### Regional and Rural Programs

This year programs were trialled in program rooms at Probation and Parole offices in regional and rural areas. Locations included Cairns, Townsville, Mareeba, Mount Isa, Emerald and Innisfail. These programs have increased access of the program to people in these areas. Programs were also facilitated from Brisbane North, Redcliffe, Southport and Logan. We would like to thank District Managers and other staff involved for their assistance.
